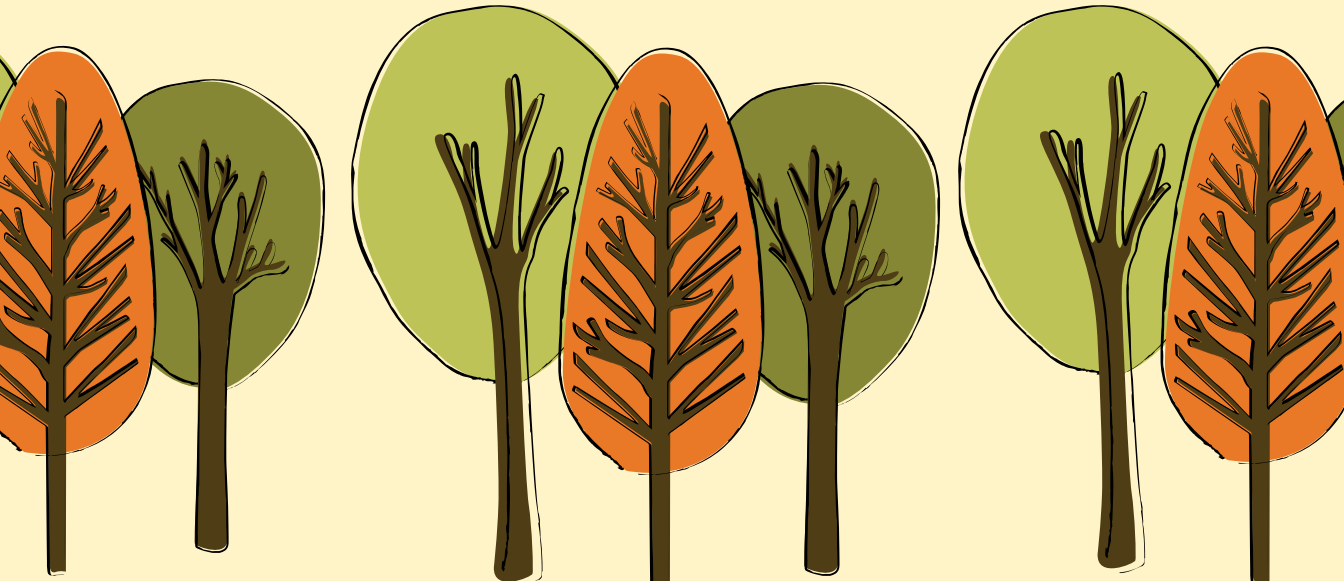

Earth Week: April 18–22, 2022

Activities... Commit to one Outside Family Activity each day during Earth Week

- a. Plant a tree in your yard
- b. Clean your ditch/curb/gutter
- c. Build a birdbath or hang a bird feeder
 - d. Ride your bike day
 - e. Adopt A Highway
 - f. Recycle, Reuse, Reduce
 - g. Use refillable water bottles
- h. Family hike to Seawall, Piers on Pleasure Island, Birdwatching
 - i. Clean around your school/church
- j. "Walk Da Block" – Families can walk around their block with bags picking up trash and **report** big trash (construction debris/tires) locations.
- k. Birdwatching – identify birds in your neighborhood; take pictures, have small children draw and color them.
 - l. Buy a Plant/Give A Plant
 - m. Decorate A Hat for Earth Day
 - n. Decorate Your Pet for Earth Day
 - o. Plant Seeds in Empty Cans
 - p. Read a nature/Earth Day Book
 - q. Have a "No TV" "No Games" "No Phone" Day
 - r. Eat a new vegetable for Earth Day
 - s. Clean out one closet, donate gently used clothing
