Notice is hereby given that the City of Port Arthur will hold a Runoff Election for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for District 3 and District 4 on Saturday, June 24, 2023, between the hours 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

I, Thurman Bartie, Mayor of the City of Port Arthur, Texas, as authorized by the City Council, do hereby order and give notice of a Runoff Election to be held in the City of Port Arthur, Texas, on Saturday, June 24, 2023, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of electing Councilmembers for District 3 and District 4 in the City of Port Arthur attached as Exhibit "B". The term of office for the Councilmembers shall be for a period of three years until his/her respective successor shall have been elected and duly qualified.

Said election shall be by Electronic Voting System as provided in Section 123.001 of the Election Code, Section 9.004, et eq., Local Government Code and the City Charter. The location of each polling place is shown in Exhibit "B". Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted each weekday and Saturday, June 17, 2023 at the following locations between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. beginning on Monday, June 12, 2023 and ending on Tuesday, June 20, 2023, with no Early Voting on Monday June 19, due to the federal holiday:


