

NOTICE FROM THE PORT ARTHUR HEALTH DEPARTMENT
THE PORT ARTHUR HEALTH DEPARTMENT REPORTS COVID-19 RELATED
DEATHS FOR PORT ARTHUR AND NEDERLAND

March 30, 2021

It is with great sadness that the City of Port Arthur Health Department is reporting COVID-19 related deaths in residents of Port Arthur and Nederland. The Port Arthur residents included a Black Female between the age range of 60-65, and a Black Male between the age range of 65-70. The Nederland resident was a White Male between the age range of 65-70. It has been determined that these individuals had underlying health conditions. The Health Department has reported seventy-two (72) COVID-19 related deaths for Port Arthur and twenty-four (24) for Nederland.

We emphasize again that COVID-19 is a very serious disease. While 80% of individuals who contract COVID-19 will have mild to moderate symptoms and fully recover, they may spread the disease to people who are at high risk. The elderly and people with underlying health conditions or weakened immune systems are at a much higher risk for developing serious complications from COVID-19. We strongly advise at-risk individuals to minimize contact with others who are ill, practice social distancing and wear a mask when in public.
